Origins of AutoCAD Cracked Accounts AutoCAD's predecessors were developed by Autodesk in the late 1970s and early 1980s. In 1971, Autodesk purchased the CAD business of its competitor, Cassell Data Products (CDP), and began producing an integrated suite of software for computer-aided drafting and design. To reduce the complexity of drafting, CDP had developed a simplified drawing system called Graphisoft. The Graphisoft system used the symbol set developed by IBIS and the TrueType font standard developed by Apple. The Graphisoft system was used in the third version of Autodesk's 3D software, ViewPoint. In 1975, ViewPoint became the first computer-aided drafting software that supported both schematic and detail drafting. ViewPoint was released for the PDP-10 microcomputer in 1977. In 1978, Autodesk incorporated the CDP line of software into the company's Microplan division, and a new name was needed. The new company name was Autodesk Inc., with the Microplan division renamed Autodesk Data Systems. Autodesk Data Systems released Autodesk Softimage in 1980, which was the first computer-aided design package to utilize CAD as an integrated part of the software. Two years later, Autodesk Data Systems released a line of CAD software, including AutoCAD, for the Apple II microcomputer. By the early 1980s, the CAD market was dominated by large companies such as The Golden Bear's, Symbolics, International Computer Systems (ICS), and Computer Applications Technology (CAT). However, two smaller competitors offered a more desktop-style CAD product for the Apple II microcomputer. The first, Picadero, was marketed by Nova Solutions in 1979. The second, Sybex, was developed by four engineers that had previously worked for Computer Design Corporation (CDC), which was purchased by Quadrality Group in 1981. The CDC engineers formed a new company in 1982 called Structures Inc. (Si) and hired four others to assist in the design of the new software application, AutoCAD. AutoCAD first shipped to beta testers in May 1983 and to the public in December 1983. AutoCAD was first introduced on the Apple II. Initially, it was a 16K self-contained Macintosh version, but it eventually became available for several different microcomputer platforms. Windows interface The development of AutoCAD was led by a small group of developers within a division of the company, Autodesk Labs. In addition, the product was the subject of a call for submissions for the first user-generated user interface for a CAD program. The resulting interface was AutoCAD LT. This interface was intended for use with AutoCAD 2002, a product launched at the same time as AutoCAD, but which was a simplified version of the product that was already developed. It used the Windows interface for launching AutoCAD. The product came with a number of plug-ins which could be installed. In 2007, AutoCAD LT was updated to use the new Windows Presentation Foundation (WPF) user interface. This change represented the transition of AutoCAD from being a pure Windows application into a Windows application that also worked with the Windows desktop. In 2017, AutoCAD was replaced with the new Autodesk Revit application that used a window interface similar to that of Revit. Licensing Prior to the release of AutoCAD 2002, a license required perpetual use of the program. AutoCAD costs \$995, and the perpetual license was required for installation. A single-user installation was available for \$495. A licensing option was added after the 2002 release, which offered the same functionality but without the perpetual license requirement. AutoCAD Professional costs \$3,000, and it is not required to use the perpetual license. This option allows additional users to be added to a license. Each model in a drawing can be set to require a new drawing (the option is called Require drawing upon creation), which allows a project manager to retain a history of work on a model. If a model is set to require a new drawing, it will not be marked as modified until the drawing is opened for the first time. Other settings include the requirement for a new drawing upon drawing export. History AutoCAD was originally developed by Vertex Systems. In 1985, Autodesk purchased Vertex Systems for \$186 million in cash, and a non-competition agreement was created. After the acquisition of Vertex, Autodesk went on to grow significantly, and its revenue increased from \$17 million in 1985 to \$241 million in 1989.
